

Patch Placement for the Back of the Vest

- The top rocker should be placed three to four inches from the neck seam which should allow proper fitting for the top rocker depending on the type of vest.
- The main Warrior of Faith back patch will be placed one inch below the top rocker (thread to thread).
- The small MM patch is to be placed one half inch to the right of the main back patch, and to the right of the warriors hand.
- The bottom rocker is optional depending on your chapters relationship with the 1% clubs. Your chapter president should get permission from the dominant 1% club before wearing it. The bottom rocker should be placed one inch from the bottom of the main back patch (thread to thread).

Patch Placement for the Front of the Vest

- See the below diagram.
- **LEFT SIDE ROCKER**—The left side rocker “WARRIOR” is earned after one year of ministry service and being in good standing. It is approved by your chapter President who then contacts the National President for it to be ordered. The left side rocker can be placed in either direction so long as its on the left side

General

- The 2nd **RIGHT** side rocker, is either “75 CREW” which represents the 7 letters in warrior and the 5 letters in faith or EPH. 6:10-20, is earned after 1 1/2 years of ministry service and being in good standing. It is approved by your chapter President who then contacts the National President for it to be ordered. The Right side rocker can be placed in either direction so long as its on the Right side.
- All vests must be black in color to maintain consistency throughout the ministry.
- The Warrior of Faith Patch - The Patch represents an attitude of heart. Worn, beaten, battered or broken, we fight on for Christ! The gold represents the majesty of His Kingdom and the red represents the blood He shed for us.
- Ministry patch consistency is very important to show our unity and strength as we fight to spread Gods word.
- Policing patches is the job of the Chapter President and Chapter Sgt at Arms. Lets all work together, in unity, for Christ.
